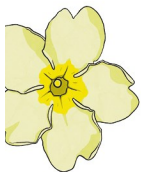




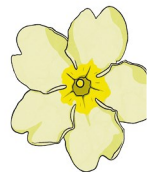
Mother's Day Treat Bags



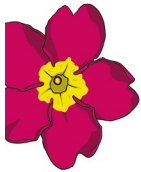
Once again this year in order to fundraise for Pre School we will be selling treat bags that include scones and brownies.

Size 1: one brownie and one scone, with jam and Cream £5

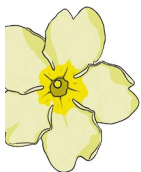


Size 2: Two brownies and two scones, with jam and Cream £7.50

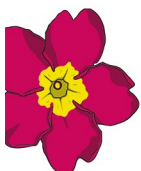
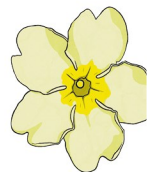


Well Done to the 22 pupils who currently have 100% attendance for the year so far.
